Dolores has left her hometown, a place of prayers and telenovelas, love motels that she has always longed to see inside, and a boy called Angelo.

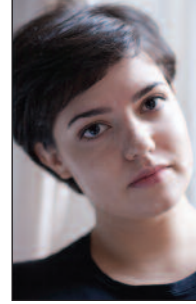
A tablecloth pinned to her head as a makeshift veil, she is found outside a convent. Dolores is the name the nuns give her, a name that refers to aches and pains.

Mistborn: Secret History builds upon the characterisation, events, and world-building of the original trilogy. Reading it without that background will be a confusing process at best.

Saying anything more here risks revealing too much. Even knowledge of this story's existence is, in a way, a spoiler.

There's always another secret.
