
## Make an origami flower for Where the River Runs Gold


Using coloured and green origami paper, create your own origami flowers, like Shifa in Where the River Runs Gold.

Step 1: take a square of paper and fold diagonally to make a triangle with the coloured side facing out. Create a crease down the middle of the triangle by folding in half again to make a smaller triangle. Unfold so you are left with the original triangle.






Step 2: Fold the bottom corners up towards the top point, not right to the centre but at a slight angle





Step 3: Fold back the corners on the left and right slightly to create your final flower head



## Now make the stem!


Step 1: Take a square of green paper and fold it diagonally down the middle to create a triangle. Open out the paper and fold the corners to the centre line with the green facing outwards, as in picture 2.






Step 2: Repeat the folds and then fold the top corners into the centre line to m



Step 3: Fold in half horizontally so that the top and bottom points are together (5), then fold in half vertically with the smallest part on the inside. Pull folds apart slightly to create the stem and leaf (6)




## Make an origami bee for your Where the River Runs Gold display!

Using the yellow origami paper we've sent you, create your own origami flowers like Shifa in Where the River Runs Gold.


Step 1: take a square of paper and cut diagonally to make a triangle.




Step 2: With the yellow side facing down, fold the bottom corners up towards the top point. Fold the corners back down, but angled slightly away from the bottom point



Step 3: Fold the top triangle backwards, a little above the existing crease (3). Unfold and fold the top section into thirds, then fold again along the crease you previously made in diagram 3.



Step 4: Fold back the left & right sides of the model to form the body of the bee. Fold the wing tips back a little to make them less pointy. Your bee is ready! You can leave it as it is or use a black marker pen to colour in the head and add sripes.
