A dazzling, panoramic epic of love and survival set in late 19th century Paris in the vein of Hilary Mantel and Susanna Clarke.


A diverse group of characters find themselves in Paris during the build up to the Franco-Prussian War of 1870, connected by their proximity to the Menagerie in the Jardin des Plantes, home and prison to the glamorous predators that draw visitors from all walks of life.

Anne is a former patient from the women's asylum, La Salpêtrière, trying to carve out a new life for herself in a world that doesn't understand her. Newcomer Lawrence is desperate to develop his talent as a photographer and escape the restrictions of his puritanical Canadian upbringing. Ellis, an army surgeon, has lived through the trauma of the US Civil War and will do anything to avoid another bloodbath.

The Franco-Prussian War ended in humiliating defeat for the French after the Siege of Paris. This terrible time was followed by yet more bloodshed: the socialist government of the Paris Commune that briefly seized power was crushed by the French Army with devastating violence.

Against this tumultuous backdrop our characters meet, fight their demons, lose their hearts and find love against the rules. We witness the ebb and flow of history and the characters whose lives are forever changed by it.




WINDMILL HILL LUCY ATKINS

ONCE UPON A RAVEN'S NEST

CATRINA DAVIES

A life on Exmoor in an epoch of change.

This is the story of a working class man, one Thomas Hedley of Exmoor, and of the planet during the period of its great acceleration towards the current climate emergency.

Born in 1955 to a poor family in Devon Thomas refused to conform. His fierce independence, recklessness and contrariness led not only to scrapes and self-inflicted dangers. Catrina Davies came to know him in his last years and has told his life and times in his own words, creating a rich, pungent language in a knowing, poetic and poignant voice.

He tells of his accumulation of engines, tools and guns, the complexity of his connection to nature, the animals he loved and his desire to hunt them. He recounts the terrible consequences of his fatal attraction to risk and machinery which led to his being paralysed for the last years of his life, confined to a wheelchair, hopelessly dependent but still watching, noticing, recording, loving the world.

The narrative is interwoven with a sequence of factual entries that chart the impending climate catastrophe and the consequences of our collective choice to ignore the warning of an environment on the verge of collapse.

In Davies's miraculous retelling of Thomas Hedley's life it is as if a world has been remembered rather than written.



Nina Allan's new novel is a work of the greatest imaginative power, an investigation of the human need to make connections, to find causes and effects, however fantastic.



Will Russia continue its vicious circle of upheaval and autocracy, or will its people find a way out of history – and how can we help?

Born in 1961 in Moscow, Mikhail Shishkin is one of the most prominent names in contemporary Russian literature, and is the only author to have won all three major Russian Literary Prizes. His novel *Taking Izmail* will be published in 2024.

WHO IS ADA?

Ada is not one woman, but many, and she is all women. She experiences the hardship but also the joy of womanhood: she is a victim, she offers resistance, and she fights for her independence.

This kaleidoscopic debut from Sharon Dodua Otoo paints an astonishing picture of femininity and resilience with deep empathy and humour.

Sharon Dodua Otoo is an activist, writer and poet living in Berlin. Born in London to Ghanaian parents, she emigrated to Germany and now writes in German. Her first short story in German was awarded the 2016 Bachmann Prize, one of Germany's most renowned literary awards.





A man finds himself in a church somewhere in the Westfjords, not knowing how he got there, or why. It's as if he has lost all his bearings.



The stories in Your Absence Is Darkness are embedded within each other, forming an extraordinary mosaic, as if Stefánsson had wanted to reconstitute the lost memory not of a character, but of all of humanity.

Jón Kalman Stefánsson's novels have been longlisted for the *Independent* Foreign Fiction Prize, the Man Booker International Prize, and have twice been the winner of the Oxford-Weidenfeld Translation Prize in Philip Roughton's translations.

THE CHOICE

MICHAEL ARDITTI

A rich and powerful exploration of desire, sin and redemption, by one of our best chroniclers of faith in the 21st century.

As a woman in the early 1980s, Clarissa Phipps is unable to pursue her vocation to the priesthood. Instead, she joins the BBC's religious affairs department, where she is sent to interview celebrated artist. Seward Wemlock, about the panels he is painting for an ancient Cheshire church.

Thirty years on, Clarissa, now rector of that same church, chances upon Brian, the chief bell-ringer and husband of her closest friend, fondling fifteen-year-old David. Dismissing David's claim that they are in love, Clarissa is obliged to act. Will she choose friendship or conscience, sympathy or her official duty of care?

The fallout from that choice forces her to reflect on the original controversy over Wemlock's panels and her concerns about his relationship with the teenagers who modelled for Adam and Eve. Had she acted on the whispers that reached her at the time, how many lives her own included - would have turned out differently?

The Choice is a rich and powerful exploration of desire, sin and redemption, questioning whether it's possible, let alone prudent, to separate the art from the artist. It examines the fault lines in both religious and secular society, from the AIDS crisis and the struggle for women's ordination in the 1980s to the culture wars of today. Richly comic and deeply compassionate, The Choice is a remarkable synthesis of the sacred and profane.



CARLOS FONSECA

A dazzling novel of three losses and three quests, for readers of Bolaño, Borges, Calvino and Sebald.

English writer Aliza Abravanel tries, in a battle with aphasia, to finish her book. A last indigenous speaker is confronted with the fading of his culture and language while an anthropologist struggles to prevent it. And through the construction of an esoteric theatre of memory, a survivor of the Guatemalan genocide of the 1970s and '80s seeks to recover the memories lost after the traumas of war.

Behind these three threads lies the narrator's own story: Julio, a disillusioned university professor, must try to understand and complete his friend Aliza's novel, and come to terms with a past he shared with her but has blanked for thirty years.

From the Guatemalan wilderness to the high Peruvian Amazon, passing through Nueva Germania, the anti-Semitic commune founded in Paraguay by Nietzsche's sister, Austral takes us on a long journey south, following a trail of ecological and cultural destruction to excavate contemporary xenophobia.

It is the first UK publication for a Costa Rican writer selected for the Hay Festival's Bogotá 39, Granta's Best Young Spanish Language Novelists and Encyclopaedia Britannica's "Young Shapers of the Future".

Carlos Fonseca was born in Costa Rica in 1987, brought up in Puerto Rico and studied in the USA. His previous novels, Colonel Lágrimas and Natural History, received wide acclaim. He is a lecturer in Spanish at Trinity College, Cambridge.
