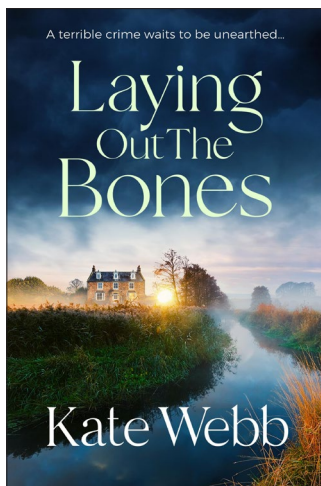

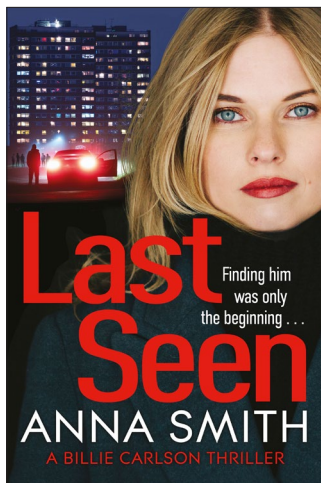
The second twisty Wiltshire-set crime novel in the DI Lockyer Series. Perfect for fans of Ann Cleeves and Val McDermid.

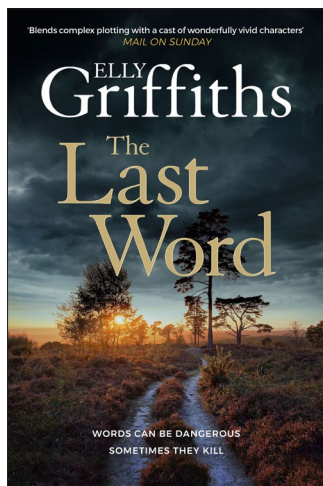

A cosy, twisty mystery that reintroduces the glorious characters we met in the bestselling *The Postscript Murders*.

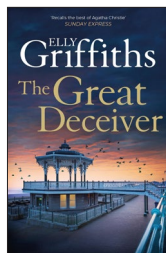

Nordland. A region in the Norwegian Arctic; a remote valley that stretches from the sea up to the mountains and the glacier of the Blue Man.

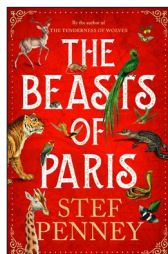

As the search for Daniel widens, the police open a disused mine in the mountains. They find human remains, but this body has been there for decades, its identity a mystery.

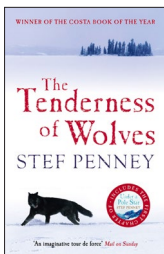

SHAKESPEARE'S SISTERS

Four Women Who Wrote the Renaissance

This remarkable work explodes our notion of the Shakespearean period by drawing us into the lives of four extraordinary women.

In an innovative and engaging narrative of everyday life in Shakespeare's England, Ramie Targoff carries us from the sumptuous coronation of Queen Elizabeth in the mid-16th century into the private lives of four women writers working at a time when women were legally the property of men. Some readers may have heard of Mary Sidney, accomplished poet and sister of the famous Sir Philip Sidney, but few will have heard of Aemilia Lanyer, the first woman in the 17th century to publish a book of original poetry, which offered a feminist take on the crucifixion, or Elizabeth Cary, who published the first original play by a woman, about the plight of the Jewish princess Mariam. Then there was Anne Clifford, a lifelong diarist, who fought for decades against a patriarchy that tried to rob her of her land in one of England's most infamous inheritance battles.

These women had husbands and children to care for and little support for their art, yet against all odds they defined themselves as writers, finding rooms of their own where doors had been shut for centuries.

Targoff uncovers the treasures left by these women, offering a much-needed female perspective on life in Shakespeare's day.

Ramie Targoff is the author of multiple books on Renaissance poetry and religion and is the recipient of a Guggenheim Fellowship. She is Professor of English, co-chair of Italian Studies, and the Jehuda Reinharz Director of the Mandel Center for the Humanities at Brandeis University.

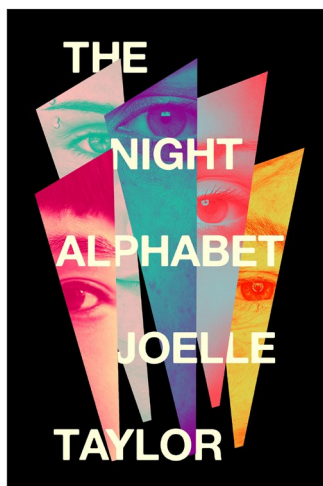

Set across geographies and timespans, *The Night Alphabet* is a dazzlingly bold and original work, a deep investigation into human nature.

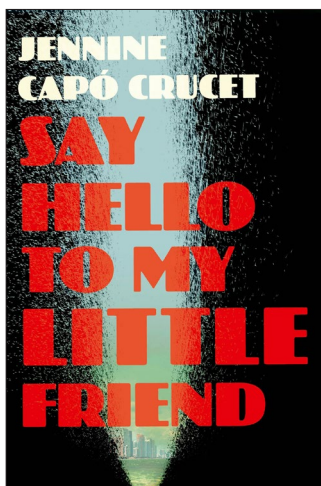
A woman walks into a tattoo parlour. But this is no ordinary woman, and this is Hackney in 2233. Jones' body is covered in tattoos but she wants to add one final inking to her gallery – a thin line of ink mixed with blood that connects her body art together, creating a unique map.

As the two artists set to work, Jones tells them the story behind each tattoo. As Jones is no ordinary woman, these are no ordinary stories: each one represents a doorway to a life Jones fell into, a 'remembering'. Some of these lives were in the past, others in the future, some are sideways, but each of them connects Jones to the two tattoo artists in some way, though they are unaware of it.

We visit the dystopian cities of the Quiet Men, the coal mines of 19th century Lancashire, join a gang of vigilante sex workers, enter the world of an INCEL murderer, haunt the old Maryville gay bar, and uncover plans to genetically modify female children. Each of the stories brings us closer to Jones' truth, and how her life is intricately interwoven with that of the women tattooing her body.

Joelle Taylor is a queer, working class author of six plays and four collections of poetry, most recently *C+nto* & *Othured Poems*, winner of the T. S. Eliot Prize for Poetry. She was made a Fellow of the Royal Society of Literature in 2022.

The result is incandescent.

Jón Kalman Stefánsson is perhaps best known for his trilogy – *Heaven and Hell*, *The Sorrow of Angels* and *The Heart of Man* (winner of the Oxford-Weidenfeld Translation Prize) – and for *Fish Have No Feet* (longlisted for the International Booker Prize).

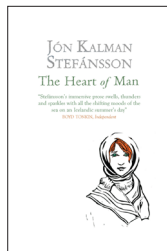

Is Duarte a real-life version of one of the heroes in the teenage magazines of her childhood? And what on earth does it mean when her dementia-suffering grandmother says that Portugal's former dictator is part of their family story?

With precise language and acute psychological insight, Cardoso creates a multifaceted character of great strength. Ironic, but by no means distanced, *Eliete* reflects on an apparently ordinary life against the background of a three-generation story of the 20th and 21st centuries in Portugal.

Dulce Maria Cardoso is a Portuguese writer who spent her childhood in Angola, before returning to Portugal following the Angolan War of Independence. Her novels have won various prizes including the EU Prize for Literature and the Portuguese Pen Club Award.
