But when the body of the professor is found, still dressed in his pyjamas and spreadeagled on a hotel lawn miles from home, things get a little unexpected for the Wilkinses. Will Ray keep on top of the brief? Will Ryan keep it together?

Simon Mason has pursued parallel careers as a publisher and an author. A Voice in the Night is the fourth book in the DI Ryan Wilkins Mysteries.




